Using FY23 results as a baseline measure, the district shall increase its CCRPI score each year by 3% of the gap between the baseline and 100.

- *Increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding grade-level Reading standards by 15%, from 47% to 54.05%, by the end of the school year.*
- *Increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding grade-level Math standards by 15%, from 46% to 52.9%, by the end of the school year.*
- *Increase the percentage of students meeting or exceeding grade-level Science standards by 15%, from 44% to 50.6%, by the end of the school year.*
